

BOPTYS SMS 03 Crisis Management Plan

1. Race Fleet Emergency – MOB, collision, foul weather

- In the event of danger to life the race will be abandoned and the rescue co-ordination will be done by the Race Officer (RO).
- Notify Emergency Services as required Phone 111 (Fire, Ambulance, Police) and/or Coastguard NZ on VHF CH 02.
- Participating boats will, in the first instance, provide support and assistance. If necessary, request further assistance. When the area is clear return to safe area.

2. Boat Park Incident; Accident, fall, fire

- Deal with immediate emergencies in the area and visibility. Assessing needs
- Notify Emergency Services as required Phone 111 (Fire, Ambulance, Police)
- Contain and secure site as necessary
- Document and report the incident

3. Okawa Bay Ramp and/or Jetty Incident

- Deal with immediate emergencies in the area and visibility. Assessing needs
- Notify Emergency Services as required Phone 111 (Fire, Ambulance, Police)
- Contain and secure site as necessary
- Document and report the incident

4. BOPTYS Clubroom Incident

- Deal with immediate emergencies in your area and visibility. Assessing needs
- Notify Emergency Services as required Phone 111 (Fire, Ambulance, Police)
- Contain and secure site as necessary
- Document and report the incident
